Tense

Tenses denote the time of action. Time can be divided into three parts - Present, Past and future.

The part of speech that is chiefly concerned with the passage of time is the verb. So the verb has many tenses. A verb may refer to:

1. Present Time
2. Past Time
3. Future Time

Tense = Tempus (Latin) = time

1. Present Tense:-

A verb that refers to present time is said to be in the present tense.

e.g. I play hockey.

2. Past Tense:-

A verb that refers to the past time is said to be in the past tense.

e.g. we ate food.

⑥ Subject Verb agreement:-

A verb must agree with its subject in Number and in Person i.e. if the subject is in the singular number, the verb also must be in singular and if it is in the plural, the verb also must be in the plural. If the subject is in the first person the verb also must be in the first person and if the subject is in the third person, the verb also must be in the third person.

e.g. He eats.

They eat.

Modals

An auxiliary verb is a verb that helps to form the moods, tenses or voices of other verbs.

There are 16 auxiliary verbs in English. They are divided into ^{two} categories.

1. Primary auxiliaries:-

The auxiliaries — Be, Have and Do are called Primary auxiliaries.

2. Modal auxiliaries:-

The auxiliaries — will, would, shall, should, can, could, May, Might, Must, ought to, Dare, Need and used to are called Modals.
